

WHAT ARE BASIC NEEDS FOR A PRECASTER STARTING PRODUCTION OF PRECAST PRODUCTS?


Production of precast products is a complicated process mastered by many entrepreneurs. The requirements break down into four "basic needs":

- I. Forms with desired shape are necessary to hold wet concrete until it becomes solid.
- II. A concrete with desired qualities is necessary as basic material to fill the forms and create the product.





III. A method of conveying the wet concrete and depositing it in the form.
